

MICKEY COX ATHLETIC CONTRACT

The following athletic contract applies to all students who represent Mickey Cox Elementary in a co-curricular program. Athletes will be asked to make this commitment prior to the start of the season/activity and abide by its conditions for the remainder of that season.

1. Team Regulations

- a. Academic Qualifications
 - 1.) The student/athlete must maintain a 2.0 GPA (C+ average) to participate in our co-curricular program.
 - 2.) Any student falling below a 2.0 GPA at the end of a grading period will be placed on academic probation for the following grading period. While on academic probation, the student will be required to attend our Study Lab one day a week for nine weeks. Any student placed on the academic probation list for two consecutive grading periods will be ineligible to participate in any co-curricular program until they can re-establish a 2.5 GPA at the end of the grading period.
- b. Attendance
 - 1.) The student must be in attendance the day of performance unless verified by the principal.
- c. Citizenship
 - 1.) Citizenship is to be satisfactory as judged by the principal. Students with serious discipline referrals may not participate in practice and/or subsequent games. The principal will have the discretion to suspend game practice and/or game privileges.
- d. Uniforms and Equipment
 - 1.) It is a player's responsibility to return all uniforms and equipment issued to him/her at the end of the participation or be responsible for the payment of items not returned.

2. Quitting Policy

- a. If an athlete quits and is discharged from a team without release from his/her coach, he/she is not to join another team until the end of the season of the sport he/she has left.

3. Participation

- a. A student will abide by the Code of Ethics for the duration of each sport season in which he/she participates.
- b. An unexcused absence from school will disqualify an athlete from participation in the subsequent game or event. An unexcused absence from practice will jeopardize an athlete playing in the subsequent game.
- c. The student will submit the following items *prior to practice* with the team:
 - 1.) Insurance Verification Form
 - 2.) Emergency Procedure Card
 - 3.) Signed statement for Code of Ethics
