1st Semester Criteria for Earning BLOCK MC and ALL-STAR AWARD

Please note that Block MC has been modified due to limited activities being offered due to COVID. Second semester will also be modified according to restrictions.

Mind:

4th Grade: Three points to earn Block MC and to points to earn All-Star

5th and 6th Grades: Four points to earn Block MC and three points to earn All-Star

Scholarship:

iReady Math and ELA Lessons (4th/5th/6th): Students will earn one (1) point per semester for completing one lesson per week in ELA and Math and scoring a minimum of 80% on each lesson.

Co-Curricular:

Choice Music: Band/Choir/Strings (5th/6th): Earning an effort grade of an "O" (Outstanding) both quarters of each semester in the School Choice Music Program earns the student one (1) point per semester.

Essay/Poster Contest (4th/5th/6th): Participation in any of the essay and/or poster contests offered outside of the school will earn one (1) point per semester. *Participation in this context means submitting a completed poster or essay prepared by the student which is acceptable to the teacher for entry into competition at the school level.*

GATE (4th/5th/6th): Students participating in GATE program may earn (1) point per semester. Points will be earned by consistent participation and completion of all required activities designed by the GATE Coordinator.

SPIRIT

4th Grade: Three points to earn Block MC and two points to earn All-Star

5th and 6th Grade: Three points to earn Block MC and two points All-Star

Student Leadership/Community Service

Student Council (5th/6th): A student will receive one (1) point for running for an office.

Positivity Project Activities(4th/5th/6th): Students will receive one (1) point for participating in Positivity Project activities that will be offered each month. (Must complete one for first quarter and two for second quarter)

B.E.A.R. Club (4th/5th/6th): Students will receive (1) point for completing a quarterly reading log that will include 60 minutes of reading per week along with a summary of weekly reading.

Human Relations Council (4th/5th/6th): Students who are nominated to represent their class on the Human Relations Council may earn one (1) point per semester.

Community Service (4th/5th/6th): Students dedicating time outside of school to serve the needs of our community may receive one (1) point per semester for four hours of volunteering. Participation must be verified with a signature from a supervisor in the organization volunteer hours were completed.
