Our EL students showed a lower percentage. This year we are making sure we are providing extra support for our kids, especially in math where our scores were lower. Dr. Pitts shared that teacher's discussed the vocabulary piece of the math is where the discrepancy is. Ms. Floth share information on our accelerated reader program. Ms. Floth also shared the recent purchase of ALEKS for math.
