Attached please find the future bell schedules for in-person instruction and Clovis Connect. The bell schedules will be in effect on the following dates for each grade level listed below. These dates are also when students can return for partial day, in-person instruction, four days a week.

- Monday, November 16<sup>th</sup> – T.K., kindergarten, fifth and sixth grades
- Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup> – First and second grades
- Monday, December 7<sup>th</sup> – Third and fourth grades

Please note that **no students will be on campus on Wednesday**, per the schedule, as that will be a required Zoom day for all students. - Thursday, November 19<sup>th</sup> – 1<sup>st</sup> grade Zoom town hall meeting @ 1 p.m. (email will be sent by teacher with Zoom link)
- Thursday, November 19<sup>th</sup> – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade Zoom town hall meeting @ 2:00 p.m. (email will be sent by teacher with Zoom link)
- Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade Zoom town hall meeting @ 2:00 p.m. (email will be sent by teacher with Zoom link)
- Wednesday, December 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> grade Zoom town hall meeting @ 2:00 p.m. (email will be sent by teacher with Zoom link)

We would appreciate it if all parents would commit to taking students’ temperatures each day prior in-person instruction each day. Staff will also have daily temperature check requirements in addition to a health screening as an additional safety precaution.

Some of the non-negotiable safety protocols that we must follow for in-person instruction include:

- Masks are required for all students
- Temperatures taken every day prior to students entering classrooms
- Hands sanitized prior to entering the classroom
- Adults will only be allowed on campus in a very limited capacity (i.e. office or CARE room). Teachers will share where students report at the beginning of the day and where they may be picked up at the end of the day.
- 6-foot distancing protocols followed throughout campus (i.e. markers for students to line up, one-way hallways)

- All water fountains are not accessible. It is recommended that student bring water to school.
- All students should bring a backpack with school supplies (not to be shared). Please let your teacher know if you need a backpack or school supplies.
- Students who exhibit any of the CDC COVID symptoms will be sent to the CARE room. Once a student is sent to the CARE room, per the waiver, the student and all siblings will be sent home for a minimum of 10 days. For safety reasons, parents will be required to pick students up from the CARE room expediently.
- Bathroom breaks only. No recess.
- Breakfast and lunch will be taken home in students' backpack at the end of the day and consumed at home

Here is a list of symptoms that would require a 10-day exclusion from school:

- Fever (**100 degree or higher**) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

We are looking forward to having our kids back on campus in the most safe and secure environment possible. Thank you for standing in the gap throughout this COVID experience.
